HOW TO INCREASE YOUR SCORE

New data shows studying for the SAT for 20 hours on free Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy is associated with an average score gain of 115 points, nearly double the average score gain compared to students who don't use Khan Academy. Out of nearly 250,000 test-takers studied, more than 16,000 gained 200 points or more between the PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.

## The Statistics

HOW IT WORKS

In addition to the 115-point average score increase associated with 20 hours of practice, shorter practice periods also correlate with meaningful score gains. For example, 6 to 8 hours of practice on Official SAT Practice is associated with an average 90point increase.

A College Board spokesman said there is a change in the effect of some test prep on student SAT performance in part because the newly redesigned SAT - first administered in March 2016 - is now more aligned with material students are learning in school, and because the Khan Academy knows how to coach to get maximum results, which suggests that other companies don't.


## The Process

That's why there's test prep, a fast-growing industry of classes, tutoring, and books, all sold with the claim that they can raise a diligent high-schooler's score on the tests. The problem is: no one knows for sure if they really can.
